Case Narrative

On Monday, February 10, 2020 at approximately 0857 Patrolman Nezier C-163 was dispatched to Solid K9 Training (25 Acorn Street) for a report threats. Upon arrival, Police met with the owner, Jeffrey Gellman DOB [REDACTED] 1966 ([REDACTED]) who stated he was receiving messages from a women in New Jersey that were concerning him. Gellman stated that he received two voicemail messages on the business line from a [REDACTED] last night at approximately 2000 hours. In the voicemails, [REDACTED] stated she was going to drive up to Gellman's training facility to have a talk with him. [REDACTED] further stated that she will not let this go. Gellman stated to Police that [REDACTED] appeared to upset over a training video that surfaced online were some people believe the animal in the video is being abused. [REDACTED] has also made some comments on social media asking if the man in the video was beaten up or killed for the portrayed abuse in the video.

Although [REDACTED] made no specific threat to harm Gellman, he is still concerned for the safety of his family, himself and his business if [REDACTED] is willing to drive from New Jersey to his facility. Gellman was advised to call Police if any other comments or threats come from [REDACTED]
