Has met the requirements of IDAPA 02.04.27, Rules Governing Deleterious Exotic Animals and has been granted permission to possess the following deleterious exotic animals under the following conditions:

- 1. The Administrator or his designee is authorized to enter and inspect premises and other areas where deleterious exotic animals are held or kept. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 022)
- 2. The permit is for POSSESSION, NOT PROPAGATION, of the deleterious exotic animals listed herein.
- 3. A separate application must be submitted for each facility where deleterious exotic animals are kept. A person who receives a possession permit for deleterious exotic animals must submit a new application for each additional deleterious exotic animal that person seeks to possess. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 101)
- 4. This permit shall exist and be valid for the life of the deleterious exotic animal listed on this permit, until the permitted person no longer possesses the deleterious animal, or until the deleterious exotic animal leaves the state. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 101, Part 05)
- The Administrator may order non-permitted or illegally possessed or imported deleterious exotic animals to be removed from the state, moved to facilities that are in compliance with this chapter, or destroyed. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 120)
- 6. No person may transfer, sell, barter, trade, change ownership, or change possession of any deleterious exotic animal, unless the person receiving the deleterious exotic animal has obtained a possession permit, issued by the administrator, for the animal being transferred. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 121)
- 7. No person may release any deleterious exotic animal within the state. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 122)
- 8. Deleterious exotic animal possession or propagation permits may be revoked at any time if the Administrator finds violations of any of the provisions of the rule. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 123)
- 9. All deleterious exotic animals must be confined in appropriate facilities which are constructed and maintained to prevent escape, prevent ingress of wildlife, and assure the appropriate level of care, including maintenance of the facilities in a sanitary manner. (IDPAP 02.04.27, Section 200)
- 10. The escape of any deleterious exotic animals must be reported to the Administrator (208-332-8540) within twenty-four (24) hours of the discovery of the escape. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 202)
- 11. All deleterious animals must be identified with unique, permanent identification in the form of a microchip, unless otherwise approved by the Administrator. (IDAPA 02.04.27, Section 203)
- 12. Any person that possesses deleterious exotic animals must submit a complete and accurate annual inventory of such animals to the Administrator on or before the first day of July each year. The inventory must include the genus, species, see and identification of each animal added, transferred or died (including cause of death) during the year.
