**AGREED ORDER AND FINAL JUDGMENT FOR COSTS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Palm Beach County's Second Amended Petition for Emergency Hearing pursuant to Section 828.073, Florida Statutes (the "Petition"). After the hearing on this matter commenced, Palm Beach County (the "County") and Lisa Schoneman, Joseph Schoneman, and Kathy Long ("Respondents") stipulated that all issues in the case between the County and Respondents should be resolved by way of an Agreed Order of this Court. It appearing to the Court that the County and Respondents, all of whom were represented by counsel, have agreed to resolve all issues pending in this case, and the terms of the Agreed Order and Final Judgment for Costs appearing fair and reasonable to this Court, it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that:

1. The following horses at issue in the County's Petition are awarded to the permanent custody and ownership of the County:

1. Flynn - male 4 years old light palomino horse AID 1949140
2. Hostage - male 3 years old paint horse AID 1949141
3. Andy - male 11 years old palomino horse AID 1949142

4. Amos - male 11 years old palomino horse AID 1949143
5. Lynn - male 17 year old grey horse AID 1949144
6. Anna - female grey horse unknown age AID 1949145
7. Prince - male 12 year old gray horse AID 1949146
8. Champagne - male bay horse unknown age AID 1949147
9. Dixie - female bay horse unknown age AID 1949148
10. Sarge - male 20 year old brown and white horse AID 1949149
11. Wiggy - female 3 year old paint horse AID 1949150
12. Jack - male 7 year old brown horse AID 1949151
13. Cheyenne - female bay horse unknown age AID 1949152
14. Bullet- male bay horse unknown age AID 1949153
15. Jewell - female brown miniature horse unknown age AID 1949154

2. Pursuant to Section 828.073(4)(c)(2), Florida Statutes, Lisa Schoneman, Joseph Schoneman, and Kathy Long are jointly and severally responsible to pay the County the sum of Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$2,300.00) for the housing, medical, and miscellaneous expenses the County has incurred to care for Lynn and Prince, for which let execution issue. Said amount shall be principal, which shall accrue interest at the statutory interest rate of 6.33% per annum or .000173425 per day. Payment shall be made payable to Palm Beach County and shall be immediately delivered to the following address: Palm Beach County Division of Animal Care and Control, c/o Director, 7100 Belvedere Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33411.

3. Pursuant to Section 828.073(4)(c)(2), Florida Statutes, Lisa Schoneman and Joseph Schoneman are jointly and severally responsible to pay the County the sum of Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and 00/100 (\$12,629.00) for the housing, medical, and miscellaneous expenses the County has incurred to care for Flynn, Hostage, Andy, Amos, Anna, Champagne, Dixie, Sarge, Wiggy, Jack, Cheyenne, Bullet, and Jewell, for which let execution issue. Said amount shall be principal, which shall accrue interest at the statutory interest rate of 6.33% per annum or .000173425 per day. Payment shall be made payable to Palm Beach County and shall be immediately delivered to the following address: Palm Beach

County Division of Animal Care and Control, c/o Director, 7100 Belvedere Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33411.

4. Pursuant to Section 828.073(4)(c)(3), Florida Statutes, Respondents are enjoined from the future custody, possession or ownership of any horse of any size for a period of two years. The two-year period shall conclude on March 14, 2021.

5. Officers from the Palm Beach County Division of Animal Care and Control may perform one unannounced inspection at any of Respondents' respective properties during each quarter of the year (i.e. January – March, April – June, July – September, and October – December) until March 14, 2021, to verify compliance with paragraph 4 above. This paragraph shall not be construed to limit the police powers of the County or to prevent the County from responding to any of Respondents' respective properties in response to a complaint or investigation.

6. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter to assure compliance with this Agreed Order and Final Judgment for Costs.
