3.125(c) FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Dead animals must be not be stored in the freezer with the animal feed. A hedgehog carcass was in the freezer in the food prep area.

3.127(a) FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

Two young goats in quarantine did not have any shade from the sunlight other than being in their shelter box. Shade needs to be provided to animals housed outdoors.

3.130 WATERING.

Several water receptacles were low or out of water and many contained dirty water. A few water receptacle had a buildup of green algae.

3.131(a) SANITATION.

Excessive excreta was observed in the tiger's enclosure. Several of the feces were white in color.

Weeds and grasses need to be kept mowed/controlled on the premises as well as in the animal enclosures to facilitate good husbandry.
