#### FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

The pen for one of the raccoons had standing water and was extremely muddy. This created a condition where there was no dry area for the raccoon. This could potentially cause distress to the animal. The facility is currently in the process of renovating the pen and will be applying dirt and gravel in order to prevent a muddy condition.
