Sheltered housing facilities.

The interactive room contains 4 lemurs (2 Red Ruffed and 2 Ring Tailed) that are allowed to have direct contact with the public. While the licensee states that there is a handler present in the room during this time, there is no direct control of the animals when they have contact with customers. As per the licensee, customers are allowed to sit on a bench in the encounter room and the primates are allowed to roam free on and around the customers. Customers can be given enticements such as fruit to encourage the animals to interact with them. The licensee or one employee stands in the room to observe this.

There is a risk of direct injury to both the public and the animals in the interaction area. Animals must be under the direct control at all times during interactive sessions.
